Today a significant proportion of academic success is based on journal publication, whether you are applying for research grants, academic positions, promotion - or working on finishing your PhD. However, there is an almost infinite number of journals; domestic and international, print and open access, ranked by different indexes, etc. Once the manuscript is prepared and sent to the journal it is subjected to editorial assessment and peer review, in most cases double blind. The manuscript may be accepted (with or without revisions) or rejected and depending on this workshop is focused on different aspects on successful publication in scientific journals including an insight to what happens to your manuscript behind the scenes from **prof. David Šmahel, Masaryk University, and prof. Kristian Daneback, University of Gothenburg**, editor and associate editor of *Cyberpsychology: Journal of psychosocial research on cyberspace*. Both lecturers have extensive knowledge from their editorial work, but also from being peer reviewers and having published in a number of well-known international scientific journals.
